- VI. All participants are requested to come with Chromebook fully charged.
- VII. **The Judicial Officer shall normally avail Journey Period for the Distance between the Headquarter of Judicial Officer and Gujarat State Academy, Ahmedabad, as mentioned below:-**

•	Less than 50 kms.	Not entitled for journey period
•	More than 50 kms. to 200 kms.	Half day journey period
•	More than 200 kms.	One day journey period
•	In case, if Holiday / Public Holiday occurs in the prefix / suffix, no Journey Period shall be admissible and Journey is to be performed in all the above cases on holiday.	

- VIII. No exemption shall be granted to any of the participant judges except in case of emergency which will be decided solely by the Registrar General of High Court of Gujarat based on cause and proofs attached with exemption request.
