The following are the terms and conditions:-

- (1) They should be treated on duty during the period of the training as aforesaid including period of journey both ways, as per Instruction No.(viii) **with permission to leave headquarter.**
- (2) They will be entitled to Traveling Allowance / Daily Allowance as admissible under the Rules and Orders for the time being in force, subject to Instruction No.(viii).
- (3) The posts held by them be kept vacant during the said period.

I. Subjects: During the workshop following subjects would be discussed: (Participants are kindly requested to come with preparation.

1	Object of N.I. Act, Ingredients of offence under Section 138 of N.I. Act. Nomenclatures of cheque and issues associated with it. Insufficient of funds and other endorsement.

2	Intimation of Dishonor of cheque. Notice. Presumption as to proof of service of notice, consolidated notice, notice on company/firm, contents of notice, person authorized to receive notice, limitation period for notice, etc.
3	Complaint, delay and condonation of delay, cognizance and jurisdiction and Offences by Company.
4	Trial Procedure – Summary trial/summons trial, service of summons/ warrant. Evidence by complainant side and accused side. Further statement. Addition of party and Cr.P.C. Sec. 319.
5	Recording of evidence, passing an order under section 143A, application by complainant to give exhibit to the documents and endorsement of accused on the complaint or on separate application. Arguments etc.
6	Appreciation of evidence - Presumptions under N.I. Act & Evidence Act, burden and onus of proof, applicability of reverse onus clause, standard of proof.
7	Compounding of offence in and out of Lok Adalat, Penology – Sentence and fine, compensation-interest cost and Govind kutti and M/s. Meters and instrument judgment. Bottlenecks in disposal of cases etc.

- II. To report on **16.09.2022 at 09.30** a.m. at the Gujarat State Judicial Academy, Behind High Court of Gujarat, Sola, Ahmedabad.
- III. To attend the training in full uniform.
- IV. To intimate Academy at least 48 hours in advance on Phone 079-27664601-15, Extension – 455, for availing accommodation at the Hostel of Academy, if required. The accommodation will be provided to the participant only and not before 12 hours from the reporting time.
- V. To follow all Covid-19 Protocols/Guidelines issued by Government/Hon'ble Gujarat High Court.
- VI. To submit **detailed report** containing following parameters directly to the President, Industrial Court for perusal and guidance **within 07 days** after attending the training. Such report shall not be required to send to the Academy:
 - a) Introduction
 - b) Evaluation of Experience in detail, on each subject discussed during the training
Self-participation
 - c) Usefulness of the Course
 - d) General observations & suggestions
 - e) Conclusion
- VII. Considering the Evaluation Report, the President, Industrial Court shall take appropriate action as he/she thinks fit.
- VIII. The Judicial Officer shall normally avail Journey Period for the Distance between the Headquarter of Judicial Officer and Gujarat State Academy, Ahmedabad, as mentioned below:-

→	Less than 50 kms.	Not entitled for journey period
→	More than 50 kms. to 200 kms.	Half day journey period
→	More than 200 kms.	One day journey period
→	In case, if Holiday / Public Holiday occurs in the prefix / suffix, no Journey Period shall be admissible and Journey is to be performed in all the above cases on holiday.	

IX. No exemption shall be granted to any of the participant judges except in case of emergency which will be decided solely by the Registrar General of High Court of Gujarat based on cause and proofs attached with exemption request.
