Note :The Judicial Officer shall normally avail Journey Period for the Distance between the Headquarter of Judicial Officer and Gujarat State Academy, Ahmedabad, as mentioned below:-

→	Less than 50 kms.	Not entitled for journey period
→	More than 50 kms. to 200 kms.	Half day journey period
→	More than 200 kms.	One day journey period
→	In case, if Holiday / Public Holiday occurs in the prefix / suffix, no Journey Period shall be admissible and Journey is to be performed in all the above cases on holiday.
